Terms & Conditions

Terms

The term of membership to the Association is 1 calendar year. Renewal notices will be sent in December. Affiliate Membership is individual, not organizational. If an organization wishes to assign membership to more than one individual, additional memberships may be purchased at the individual rates.

Membership fees

Upon receipt of the dues fee by the Association, you are recorded as an Affiliate Member of the Association. Membership dues are deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense. Dues are not deductible as charitable contributions. Dues are based on a calendar year Jan. 1 – Dec. 31 and cannot be pro-rated. If a member joins mid-year they must pay for the entire year. Paid members shall be entitled to all the benefits available to Affiliate Members for the calendar year of the purchase date.

The Association may increase membership dues upon the expiration of a Member's Initial Term or Renewal Term.

Refund policy

Dues fees are non-refundable. Pro-rata refunds are not available.

Changes/Cancellation/ Transfer of Membership

Only the named Member or person authorized by the named Member may request a change in membership details.

A Member may cancel their membership at any time by providing either verbal or written notification to the Association provided both the individual making the request and the membership concerned can be positively verified. Cancellation of membership cannot be back-dated.

Upon written request, any unexpired or unused membership subscriptions, at the date of cancellation, may be transferred to another individual at the same organization, by written request.

If you upgrade your level of membership, the entire dues fee applicable to that upgraded level of membership will be payable and any unused or unexpired portion of the previous membership class will be credited at renewal.

Voting rights

Although there are various classes of membership, only AAA members of the Association have the right to vote in Board Elections and at meetings of the Association.

Lapsing of membership

Where a Member's subscription is overdue, access to membership services and benefits may be denied pending payment of any outstanding subscription or other fees.

Any Member whose subscription is overdue for more than two (2) months will cease to be a Member of the Association and will not be entitled to access any benefits and entitlements of membership. At the discretion of the Association, and upon payment of outstanding and overdue subscription fees and other charges, a person may have their membership reinstated.

Electronic Disclosure and Consent. Your submission of our electronic application shall constitute your consent to receive notices and other communications from the Association as well as being listed on the Association's website as a member.

Association on Aging in NY reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to change the terms and conditions of this Agreement at any time.
